The Jubilee scientific session of the Scientific Council of the NAS of Ukraine (NASU) on the problem “Physics of Semiconductors”, which was dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the eminent Ukrainian scientist V.E. Lashkaryov, the first Chairman of the Scientific Council of NAS of Ukraine on the problem “Physics of Semiconductors”, was held from 7 till 9 October 2003 at the Institute of Semiconductor Physics (ISP) of NASU.

The Jubilee session was opened by V.F. Machulin, Director of ISP of NASU, Corresponding member of NASU.

The greetings and speeches were presented by A.G. Naumovets, Academician-Secretary of the Division of Physics and Astronomy of NASU, Institute of Physics (IP) of NASU; S.V. Svechnikov, Academician of NAS of Ukraine, Chairman of the Scientific Council of NASU on the problem “Physics of Semiconductors”, ISP NASU; I.R. Yukhnovsky, Academician of NASU, Deputy of the Ukrainian parliament, S.M. Ryabchenko, Corresponding member of NASU, IP NASU; O.I.
